## 4. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for the Master of Divinity (M.Div.), applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Academic Requirements:
- A Bachelor's degree in Theology, Ministry, or a related field from a recognized institution.
- Applicants with a non-theological degree will be interviewed before approval
- 2. Spiritual and Ministerial Requirements:
- Evidence of Christian faith and commitment to ministry.

# **APPLICATION PROCESS:**

- 1. Complete an online application form.
- 2. Submit required documents: Academic transcripts and certificates
- 3. Interview with the Admissions Committee (if required).

# **5. ACADEMIC POLICIES**

#### **Grading System:**

A (80-100%) - Excellent

B (70-79%) - Good

### **ATTENDANCE POLICY:**

- Students are required to attend at least 80% of all classes.
- Absences beyond the limit require approval from the Dean's Office.
- Examinations & Assessments:

- Continuous assessments (assignments, presentations, discussions) 40%
- Final semester exams 60%
- Thesis evaluation based on research, originality, and oral defense.

# **6. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

To graduate with a Master of Divinity (M.Div.), students must:

- 1. Complete 72 Credit Hours within the stipulated time.
- 2. Successfully defend a master's thesis before a faculty panel.
- 3. Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0.
